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# Key Takeaways

- Electric Bill has TWO (2) forms of charges
  - Supply & Delivery
- Comparing total bill value month to month is not the most useful
  - Your usage changes
- Comparing January 2024 to 2025 is better, as your behaviors are more likely aligned
- The Town's Supply program saves money relative to not having the program, but will not mean your final total bill will be lower than some other billing period
- The Town's Supply rate will be constant until October 2026, Eversource's rate will likely rise in August 2025.
  - Any changes in the energy market (i.e. tariffs) will not impact Town supply rate, but could impact Eversource when they make changes in February and August every year
- Delivery Charges are out of the Town's control, but are set per Eversource Region, and is agnostic to the Town's Supply Program

# Preview of Future Information

- Usage Data for October – December will be available Late March/ Early April
  - This will provide us with information on how many users in town by usage class
  - This will also inform us how many kWh we use
  - From there we can begin to more accurately calculate how much the Aggregation Plan has been saving people
- Usage data reports will be Quarterly from then on
