Open Enrollment dates are November 1, 2021 - November 17, 2021
Elections will be effective January 1, 2022

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Are my preferred doctors and other providers still covered?

Review the provider directory for [Blue Cross](#) and [Harvard Pilgrim](#)

Does my current plan cover my prescription drugs?

Review the formularies for [Blue Cross](#) (including their [\\$9 list](#)) and [Harvard Pilgrim](#)
Compare tiers - are there differences between these plans?

Are there more affordable options available?

If just you and your spouse are on the plan - could you switch to 2 individual plans?
Children under 12 have preventative dental benefits through our health plans

Are there benefits that can manage my health or save me money?

Consider mail order prescriptions under Blue Cross or Harvard Pilgrim - receive a 90-day supply for a 1-month copay

[BurlingtonScripts](#) provides 90 days of brand name prescriptions for \$0 copay

Diabetes medications & supplies can be obtained for free through the [Good Health Gateway](#)

Does my dental coverage meet my current needs?

Do you need a family plan? Are all members on the plan?
Will you need orthodontic coverage (*only available on the high plan*)

Will I have any out-of-pocket dependent care expenses?

Daycare, after school care, summer camps, adult day care

Do I expect to have any out-of-pocket medical expenses?

Over-the-counter items, doctor/dental copays, vision care ([Common expenses & worksheet](#))

Does not include expenses covered by your insurance HRA/HSA
