THE GRAND UNION FLAG is considered to be the first national flag of the United States. This flag consisted of 13 red and white stripes with the British Union Flag of the time in the canton.

THE BETSY ROSS FLAG is an early design of the flag of the United States popularly attributed to Betsy Ross using the common motifs of alternating red-and-white striped field with five-pointed stars in a blue canton.


THE STAR-SPANGLED BANNER FLAG or the Great Garrison Flag was the garrison flag that flew over Fort McHenry in Baltimore Harbor during the naval portion of the Battle of Baltimore during the War of 1812.

THE NATIONAL FLAG OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA. In April 1818 Congress decided to go back to the original 13 stripes, and simply added a star each time a new state was admitted to the Union. The fifty stars on the flag represent the 50 states and the 13 stripes represent the original thirteen colonies.




